I once negotiated a real estate lease (way out of my swim lane) based on a checklist I found at acc.com; the property manager for the facility thought I was the hired real estate lawyer (for which I had no budget, so I faked it!). I found several "how to" guides on implementing virtually every compliance program required for large and small businesses. Rich in content, ACC provides tremendous resources on contracts – from clause training to negotiations to breach and remedies. Employment & Labor content may lead all other avenues of resources, but you can join Committees, leverage the Member-to-Member Q&A resources and e-Groups and so much more.

And, I haven't even mentioned the networking ops. Networking consistently is number two on attorneys' wish list of programs in our member surveys, second to contracts, so ACC leaders across the globe are focusing on unique opportunities for lawyers to network, and not always in association with CLE programs.
