



Job Listing Policy

All ACC members, regardless of their geographic location, have free access to all jobs posted on ACC's In-house Jobline. In today's highly mobile world, ACC members are constantly on the move. Some are looking to start a new career in a new destination and some need to find a new job across country due to changes in a spouse/partner's job status. Only an international job board is able to provide open access to all jobs across the United States and abroad. Jobs posted on a chapter's broadcast email list are only available to local members and therefore excludes a large section of the ACC membership who may be very interested in relocating to a different area. Chapters that are interested in offering this alternative to their local members, however, are asked to adhere to the following guidelines.

- 1) Job postings on chapter broadcast email list should be reserved as a member benefit and therefore chapters should not accept job listings from recruiters.
- 2) Recruiters interested in posting jobs should be directed to In-house Jobline.
- 3) Job postings should be a free service to chapter members and listings may not be sent beyond chapter's borders.
- 4) Job postings should only reflect local jobs. For example, if a current member asks you to promote a position available in a region outside your service area, you cannot post this job. The member should be directed to In-house Jobline.
- 5) Chapters are encouraged to promote the In-house Jobline at the bottom of all messages that contain job announcements
