S.B. 1162 Pay Transparency

- Provide employees or applicants the "pay scale."
- Employers with 15 or more employees must include the pay scale with any job posting.
- Employers with over 100 employees and at least one California-based employee have increased data reporting requirements.







S.B. 1334 Meal and Rest Periods for Hospital Employees

 Extends CA meal and rest period laws to previously-excluded groups.

A.B. 1041 Family Care Leave Expanded

- Employees may take leave to care for a "designated person."
- Employee may be limited to one designated person per 12-month period.

A.B. 2188 Cannabis Usage Discrimination

- Employers cannot punish employees who use marijuana outside work.
- Preemployment drug screenings allowed.
- Does not apply to employees in building and construction trades or jobs requiring federal clearance.



A.B. 152 COVID-19 Relief: Supplemental Paid Sick Leave

- Extends COVID-19 supplemental paid sick leave entitlements.
- Expires January 1, 2023.

A.B. 1751 Workers' Compensation and COVID-19



- Workers' compensation claim based on COVID-19 presumptively compensable after 30 or 45 days.
- Presumption of injury if another employee tests positive.
- Presumption effective until January I, 2024.

S.B. 1044 Expanded Retaliation Protection

 Employers must protect employees from retaliation for leaving work during unsafe emergency conditions.

 Expands the definition of "eligible employers" to those employing at least one CA eligible employee.
