What is "doing business in California"?



"Doing Business in California"

- Headquarters are in California
- Employees in California
- Entity incorporated in California
- California 'foreign entity'
- Out of state with sales/transactions into California



You are a "business" under CCPA if you "buy, sell, share, and/or receive the personal information of at least 50,000" of these, per year

CCPA Scope

- at least \$25,000,000 in annual gross revenues;
- buy, sell, share, and/or receive the personal information of at least 50,000 California consumers, households or devices, per year; or
- derive at least 50% of your annual revenue from selling California consumers' personal information



CCPA Scope

- You collect **California consumers' personal information** (or such information is collected on your behalf)
- You determine the purposes and means of processing California consumers' personal information
- You control or are controlled by an entity that meets the above criteria and share common branding with that entity



CCPA does not apply to these organizations who are subject to GDPR






What is "Inferences drawn from any of the information identified in this subdivision"



Other types of Personal Information:

- unique personal identifier
- online identifier
- Internet Protocol address,
- browse and search history
- purchase history or tendencies
- interactions with ads and apps
- email address
- audio, electronic, visual, thermal, olfactory, or similar information.

What is "publicly available information"?



Publicly Available Information

- Lawfully made available from federal, state, or local government records
- But NOT:
 - Biometric information collected without knowledge;
 - Data used for an incompatible purpose; or
 - Consumer information that is de-identified / aggregated



John Doe, an employee in your Sacramento office wants a copy of his HR file. This CCPA proposed amendment supports an answer of "No, Thank you"





What is "AB 25"?



AB 25

Excludes

- Employees
- Job applicants
- Contractors and agents

From the definition of "consumer"





AB 25 (As amended)

- Disclosure requirement
- Sunset 2021
- Some access requirements already under California labor laws
- Only information <u>collected from</u> a person by a business <u>in the course of the person acting as</u> <u>a job applicant / employee</u>

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
What are "all obligations under the CCPA"



GLBA Entities

• Out: Non-Public Information (NPI) under GLBA

• In: Everything else (clickstream, lead generation)






Health Information

- Out:
 - Protected Health Information ("PHI") under HIPAA
 - Information under the Confidentiality of Medical Information Act
- In:
 - HIPAA entity's non-PHI information (lead generation, marketing)
 - De-identified PHI
 - Health information of a non-HIPAA entity

BUT: No "special category" status







What are "None"?



De-Identified Data (1)

- De-identified data is out of scope for CCPA
- Definition of de-identified is different than GDPR
- Definition may change through amendment



De-Identified Data (2)

Information that cannot reasonably identify, relate to, describe, be capable of being associated with, or be linked, directly or indirectly, to a particular consumer Information which does not relate to an identified or identifiable natural person or to personal data rendered anonymous in such a manner that the data subject is not or no longer identifiable



De-identified Data (3)

CCPA	GDPR		
Implement technical safeguards that prohibit re-identification	Account must be taken of "all" the means "likely reasonably" to be used for identification by the controller and third		
Implement business processes that specifically prohibit re-identification	parties, paying special attention to what has lately become, in the current state of		
Implement business processes to prevent inadvertent release of de-identified information	technology "likely reasonably" (given the increase in computational power and tools available).		
Make no attempt to re-identify the information			



If you are under this age, the CCPA opt-out requirement flips to an "Opt-In"





What is "16"?



Under 16 Opt-In

- $13 16 \rightarrow Opt In$
- Under $13 \rightarrow$ Opt in by the parent
- Cannot willfully disregard the age





If you are a service provider for a "business" under CCPA, you are required to take these actions





What is "Process the information only for the specific purpose of performing the services, or as otherwise permitted by this title"?



Amend your Art 28 DPA

- Must Enter into an agreement with the "business"
 - Use only for the provision of the services
 - Not sell
 - Certify that will comply
- Allow compliance with consumer rights under CCPA
- Facilitate opt outs



...and some Controller/controller agreements too

- Some CCPA Service Providers might be GDPR Data Controllers
- "Business purpose" is broader than Art 28 and includes:
 - security incidents / fraud /debugging/ quality control
 - short term use
 - advertising, marketing, analytics
 - internal research
- CCPA imposes requirements on "third parties" as well



In an M&A deal, you do not need to give an opt-out of sharing information unless the target wants to do this





What is "use the information differently than it was used before"?



Sharing Information – M&A

- CCPA (Merger, Acquisition OR bankruptcy):
 - Consistent with the purpose → No Opt Out
 - Materially inconsistent with the promises → Opt Out

• GDPR

- Bankruptcy + consistent / inconsistent -> likely need consent (Opt In)
- Asset deal + consistent / inconsistent -> likely need consent (Opt In)
- Merger + consistent -> No opt out
- Merger + inconsistent -> Opt In.







Bake, closeout and garage are all types of this action that requires you to give an Opt-Out under CCPA






What is a "Sale"?



A Sale Under the CCPA Is:





Sale (1)

Action	ССРА	GDPR
Sale	Opt Out	Opt In (consent)
At the consumer's direction	No opt out	Opt out (withdraw consent at any time)
Security incidents / fraud / debugging / quality control (by Service Provider)	No opt out	Opt out if rights outweigh the legitimate interest of business
Short term use (by Service Provider)	No opt out	Opt out (consent/legit interest test)



Sale (2)

Advertising, marketing, analytics (by Service Provider)	No opt out	Opt out (consent/legit interest test)
Internal research (by Service Provider)	No opt out	Opt out (legit interest test)
M&A / Bankruptcy	Opt out (unless use for an incompatible purpose)	Opt In (unless merger + compatible use)
Communicating an opt-out preference	No opt out	No opt out



When you disclose personal information to a third party, the third party may further disclose this information only if this happens

Privacy Notice – Requirements (1)

	Contact information of controller and controller representative
	Contact details of DPO
Categories of personal information collected in past 12 months	
Categories of personal information sold in past 12 months	Categories of personal data
Categories of personal information disclosed for business purpose in past 12 months	
Purposes for which will be used	Purposes of the processing; legal basis of the processing



Privacy Notice – Requirements (2)

CCPA	GDPR
Catagorias of accuracy from which collected	Source of the data
Categories of sources from which collected	legitimate interest of the controller or a third party
Categories of third parties to whom sold, by category of information sold to each	recipients or categories of recipients of the personal data
	purpose and legal basis of sharing with third parties
	cross border transfer and appropriate or suitable safeguards for the transfer and how to access them.
	period for which data will be stored or criteria to determine it



Privacy Notice – Requirements (3)

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What is "that the value is reasonably related to the value provided [to the consumer] by the consumer's information"?



Financial incentives

- Requires opt-in after full disclosure
- Cannot be unjust, unreasonable, coercive, or usurious
- May offer financial incentives, including payments as compensation
- May also offer a different price, rate, level, or quality of goods or services to the consumer if that price or difference is directly related to the value provided to the consumer by the consumer's data



This new addition to CCPA-compliant websites will provide individuals with an easy way to opt-out of the sale of their information





What is "the Do Not Sell my Information Button"?



Do Not Sell My Information

- a clear and conspicuous link on website
- must not require a consumer to create an account in order to optout
- respect a consumer's opt-out for at least 12 months before requesting that the consumer authorize the sale of the consumer's personal information



If you receive an access request on July 2, 2020, you need to provide information dating back to this date





What is "July 3, 2019"?

Specific pieces of personal information	Copies of personal data
Categories of personal information collected about the consumer in 12 preceding months	
Categories of personal information the business sold in the 12 preceding months	Categories of personal data processed at any time
Categories of personal information the business disclosed for a business purpose in the 12 preceding months	



Right of Access (2)

CCPA	GDPR
The categories of sources	Sources of personal data
The business or commercial purpose for collecting or selling personal information	Purpose of the processing
Categories of third parties the business disclosed personal information to	Recipients / categories of recipients
	Data retention
	Correction / erasure
	Complaint
	Automated decision making
	Cross border transfer

What is "the right of deletion / erasure"?



Right of Erasure - Triggers

CCPA	GDPR
Collected from the consumer	Personal data concerning him or her
Verifiable consumer request	Verifiable request
Direct service providers to delete	Require data processor to erase; inform controllers if data made public
No legal basis required	Legal basis
	 No longer necessary for the purpose
	Consent is withdrawn
	Object to the processing
	 Unlawfully processed
	Compliance with EU legal obligation
	 Information society services for kids











What is "an internal use that is reasonably aligned with the expectations of the consumer based on the consumer's relationship with the business"?



Right of Erasure – Exceptions

ССРА	GDPR
complete a transaction	Necessary for the purpose
provide a good or service requested by the consumer	
perform a contract between the business and the consumer	
free speech or another legal right	freedom of expression and information
comply with the California Electronic Communications Privacy Act	compliance with EU legal obligation under Union or Member State law
comply with a legal obligation	
	for the establishment, exercise or defense of legal claims



RIGHT OF ERASURE - EXCEPTIONS

ССРА	GDPR
engage in research in the public interest	task carried out in the public interest / official authority
	public interest in the area of public health
	archiving purposes in the public interest, scientific or historical research purposes or statistical purposes
detect security incidents, protect against malicious, deceptive, fraudulent or illegal activity	
debug to identify and repair functionality errors	
internally in a lawful manner compatible with the context in which the consumer provided it	
solely internal uses aligned with the consumer's expectations
