Modernization Proposal in the European Parliament

n Committee on Economic and Monetary Affairs amendment of modernization proposal

 n After Commissioner Monti intervention, Parliament rejected the amendment.
 n But Commissioner Monti made a significant concession.

Comm'r Monti's Concession

n Background: The John Deere case

- u Lawyer had advised that conduct posed legal risks
- u Client proceeded despite the risks
- u Commission the advice to justify a higher fine



Comm'r Monti's Concession

n "[I]f Amendment No 10 is rejected, I can give an assurance to propose [that] the Commission will not regard as an aggravating circumstance the existence of texts demonstrating that the company' s in-house lawyers have alerted the directors to the unlawfulness of conduct"

Efforts to Enlist US Agencies

n US View:

u Avoiding violations is a lot better than catching them

 In-house counsel are the first line of defense against anticompetitive behavior

 Good legal advice makes it easier to catch cartel behavior

Prospects

n This will take a long time.
n But shouldn't give up.
u Progress with member states.
u New personnel from time to time.
u It's the right policy.

 n Avoid creating harmful evidence
 n But still have to do your job effectively
